Subject: Urgent Concerns Regarding Unresolved Burglary Investigation and Sytematic Discrimination

Dear Representative Hanbidge,

My name is Scott Testa, and my partner, Hulda, and I were victims of a distressing home burglary in Whitpain Township on September 19, 2024. Despite the severity of this crime, the Whitpain Police Department and township leadership have failed to take appropriate action and have remained unresponsive.

Due to this lack of accountability, we have recently filed a federal civil lawsuit against Chief Ken Lawson and Detective Thomas Wittig in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania.

We urgently request your assistance in reviewing the circumstances of our case and in initiating an independent, third-party investigation into why our robbery remains unsolved and why the perpetrators have not been apprehended.

Through our research, we have also uncovered a troubling pattern of similar incidents in Whitpain Township that raise serious concerns about accountability and equal protection under the law:

- **Donté Perez Jones, a 35-year-old decorated United States Army veteran, died under suspicious circumstances in 2022. His case was closed quickly despite evidence and eyewitness accounts that contradicted the official narrative.**
- **Jamil Van, a former Black Whitpain police officer, pursued claims of misconduct within the department. His case ended in a settlement that left him permanently disabled—both physically and mentally—highlighting internal retaliation and a lack of safeguards for officers of color.**
- **Hulda, a Whitpain resident and my partner, was the victim of a home invasion where masked intruders broke windows and doors. These individuals were caught on video and are known, yet police failed to hold them accountable, appearing instead to shield those responsible.**

Taken together, these cases point to a deeper pattern of misconduct and selective enforcement within Whitpain Township.
